**FA07 Economics Undergraduate Program Changes
& how they may affect you!**

Overall changes

1. All students need to be very careful when registering for classes to make sure that they are not unintentionally repeating classes. Many courses have changed titles, course descriptions, prerequisites, and course number. The catalog will always have the most current information. You MUST read through the catalog when registering for classes to avoid duplication of credit.
 - Any course that has been renumbered will indicate this in the 2007 catalog course description.
 - If a course you are considering taking has the same number as a course you have taken before, but the title, course description, and/or prerequisites have changed it is STILL THE SAME COURSE.
 - If you EVER have a question about whether the course you are considering is a repeat of a class you have already taken, please talk with an advisor in Sequoyah 245.
2. Many advanced electives will recommend Econ 100C as a prerequisite for the class. Beginning Fall 2010, Econ 100C will become a prerequisite for these advanced electives; exceptions will not be made.
3. If you need to repeat Econ 172C, Econ 170A, or Econ 170B as of FA07; please talk with an advisor in Sequoyah 245.

Economics Majors

1. Econ 100C is recommended for those students who start Econ 100A in FA07 or later and can be used as an upper division Econ elective. Econ 100C is NOT recommended for any student who has completed Econ 100A-100B or Econ 170A-170B before the end of FA07.

Management Science Majors

1. Econ 170A-B and Econ 172C have been deleted as of FA07. The last time Econ 170A and 170B will be offered will be Summer 07; the last time Econ 172C will be offered is SP07.
2. To fulfill your Upper Division Microeconomics Core requirement (Econ 170A-170B). By the beginning of FA07, if you have taken and passed with a C- or better:
 - Econ 170A-170B. You have fulfilled your upper division Microeconomics core requirement.
 - Econ 170A but not Econ 170B. You will take Econ 100B to fulfill your upper division Microeconomics core requirement.
 - Neither Econ 170A nor 170B. You will take Econ 100A and Econ 100B to fulfill your upper division Microeconomics core requirement.
3. Econ 100C is recommended for those students who start Econ 100A in FA07 or later and can be used as an upper division restricted elective. Econ 100C is NOT recommended for any student who has completed Econ 100A-100B or Econ 170A-170B before the end of FA07.

Management Science Majors (continued)

4. To fulfill your Operations Research Core requirements (Econ 172A-172B-172C). By the beginning of FA07, if you have taken and passed with a C- or better:
 - Econ 172A-172B-172C. You have fulfilled your operations research core requirements.
 - Econ 172A-172B. You will need to take one additional upper division restricted elective to fulfill your Econ 172C requirement (this will bring your total number of restricted electives to four). You must PETITION the department to use a restricted elective for Econ 172C to graduate.
 - Econ 172A. You will need to take Econ 172B and one additional upper division restricted elective to fulfill your Econ 172C requirement (this will bring your total number of restricted electives to four). You must PETITION the department to use a restricted elective for Econ 172C to graduate.
 - Neither Econ 172A or 172B or 172C. You will need to take Econ 172A, Econ 172B, and one additional upper division restricted elective to fulfill your Econ 172C requirement (this will bring your total number of restricted electives to four). You must PETITION the department to use a restricted elective for Econ 172C to graduate.
5. Econ 173 and Econ 175 will be turned into a new ordered sequence, Econ 173A-173B. Each class will be offered a minimum of twice a year.
 - Econ 175 becomes Econ 173A. Prerequisites: Econ 100A or Econ 170A and Econ 120B.
 - Econ 173 becomes Econ 173B. Prerequisites: Econ 4 and Econ 173A.

Joint Math Economic Majors

1. To fulfill your Upper Division Microeconomics Core requirement (Econ 170A-170B or Econ 100A-100B). By the beginning of FA07, if you have taken and passed with a C- or better:
 - Econ 170A-170B or Econ 100A-100B. You have fulfilled your upper division Microeconomics core requirement.
 - Econ 170A or Econ 100A; but not Econ 170B. You will take Econ 100B to fulfill your upper division Microeconomics core requirement.
 - Neither Econ 170A-170B nor Econ 100A-100B. You will take Econ 100A and Econ 100B to fulfill your upper division Microeconomics core requirement.
2. Econ 172C will be offered for the last time in SP07.
3. Econ 100C is recommended for those students who start Econ 100A in FA07 or later and can be used as an upper division Econ elective. Econ 100C is NOT recommended for any student who has completed Econ 100A-100B or Econ 170A-170B before the end of FA07.

Management Science Minors

1. Econ 100A-Econ 100B can be used INSTEAD of the Econ 170A-Econ 170B option. You cannot take BOTH Econ 170A and Econ 100A; or Econ 170B and Econ 100B.
2. Econ 172C will be offered for the last time in SP07.
